


## Blue Range Hut

### Rat Bait top-up instructions

Collect rat bait (Diphacinone) from DOC office (220 South Road. Open 8am – 430pm Mon-Fri. Contact Rob Shaw, David Titchener, Hayden Barrett, Briggs Pilkington. Best to contact them 1 – 2 days before collection. 06 377 0700

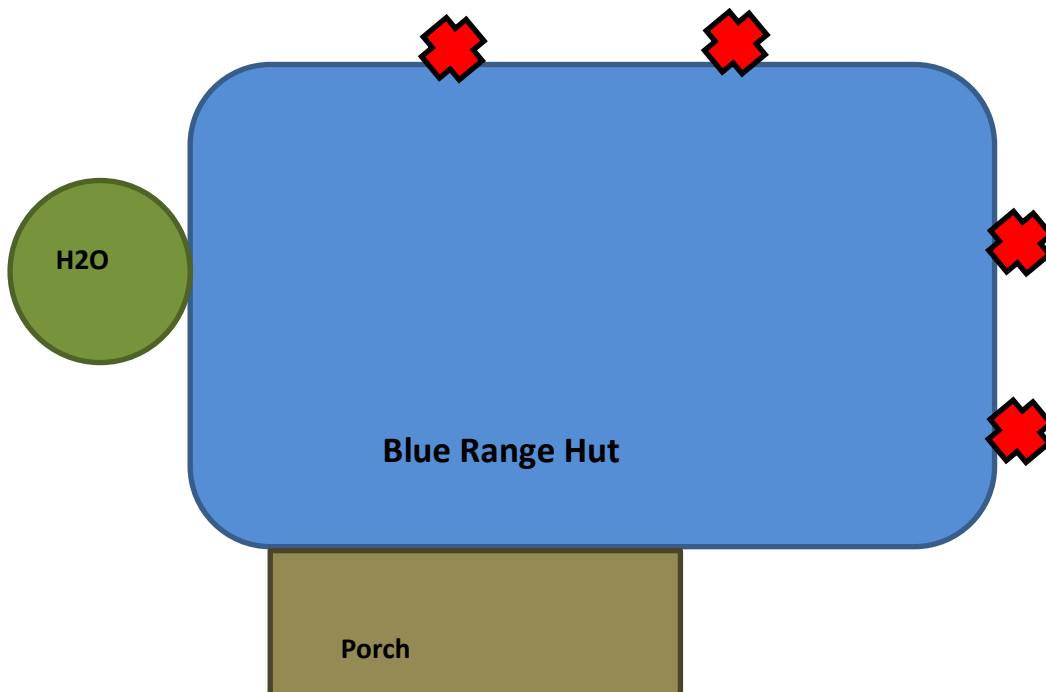
Make sure keep rat bait separate from food/drink in bag tied up. Ensure it doesn't get wet.

At Blue Range Hut:

There are 4 'tube' bait stations below the hut (just under the edges of the hut). Look for the cords tied around the hut piles. Locations marked on diagram below with 

Remove rubber washer (carefully place to one side), pull out wire part of way (so 'bent' end stays in plastic pipe but you can place bait onto wire inside the tube. Re insert wire into other pipe hole and replace washer. Place tube back under hut. Repeat until all bait in pipes.

Let Club Captain know that you have topped up bait / how many pieces / date.



## Mitre Flats Hut

### Rat Bait top-up instructions

Collect rat bait (Diphacinone) from DOC office (220 South Road. Open 8am – 430pm Mon-Fri. Contact Rob Shaw, David Titchener, Hayden Barrett, Briggs Pilkington. Best to contact them 1 – 2 days before collection. 06 377 0700

Make sure keep rat bait separate from food/drink in bag tied up. Ensure it doesn't get wet.

You will need to take a square drive screw driver.

Ask DOC for a key to the wardens room,

At Mitre Flats Hut:

There are 2 black 'meal stations' at the hut – one on the front porch under sink, other in the wardens quarters. Locations marked on diagram below with

Use screw driver to open lid of box. Place baits onto pegs inside box. Replace lid and screw down.

Let Club Captain know that you have topped up bait / how many pieces / date.
